What, Where, When?

- The 24th WSJ will take place at the Summit Bechtel Reserve in West Virginia, USA between 22nd July and 2nd August 2019.

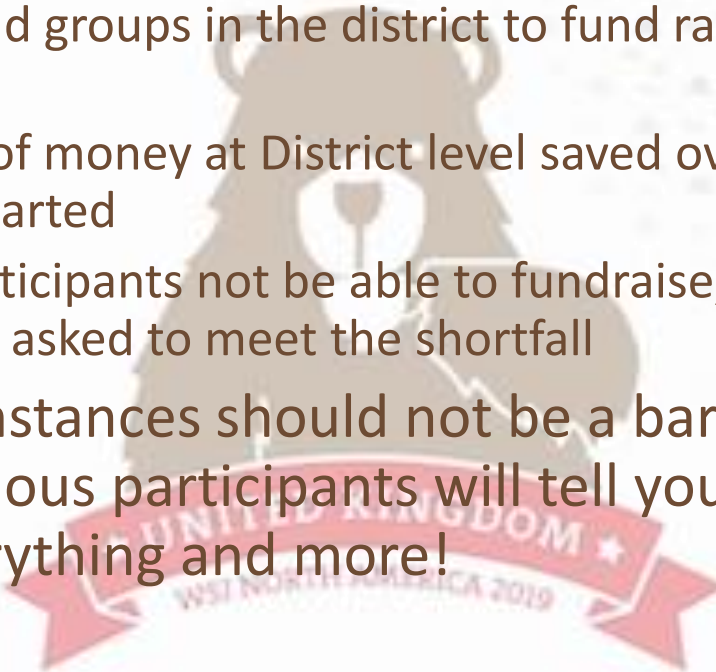


- The event is being hosted by the Boy Scouts of America, Scouts Canada and Scouts of Mexico.
- 45,000 young people and adult volunteers are expected to attend from over 150 countries.



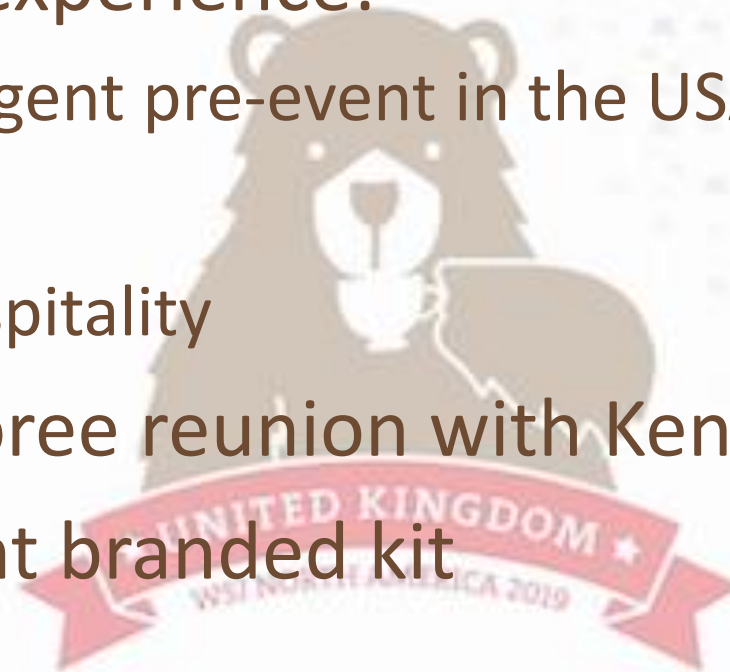
How Much?

- The cost will be £3945 which includes the cost of the Jamboree (£3495) and a Kent fee for kit and pre-camps.
- Fundraising will be a key component of the Jamboree
 - Each young person will need to work individually and with the other participants and groups in the district to fund raise their jamboree fees.
 - There is a pot of money at District level saved over the past four years to get things started
 - Should the participants not be able to fundraise, as a last resort parents will be asked to meet the shortfall
- Personal circumstances should not be a barrier to applying to the event. Previous participants will tell you they fully fundraised everything and more!

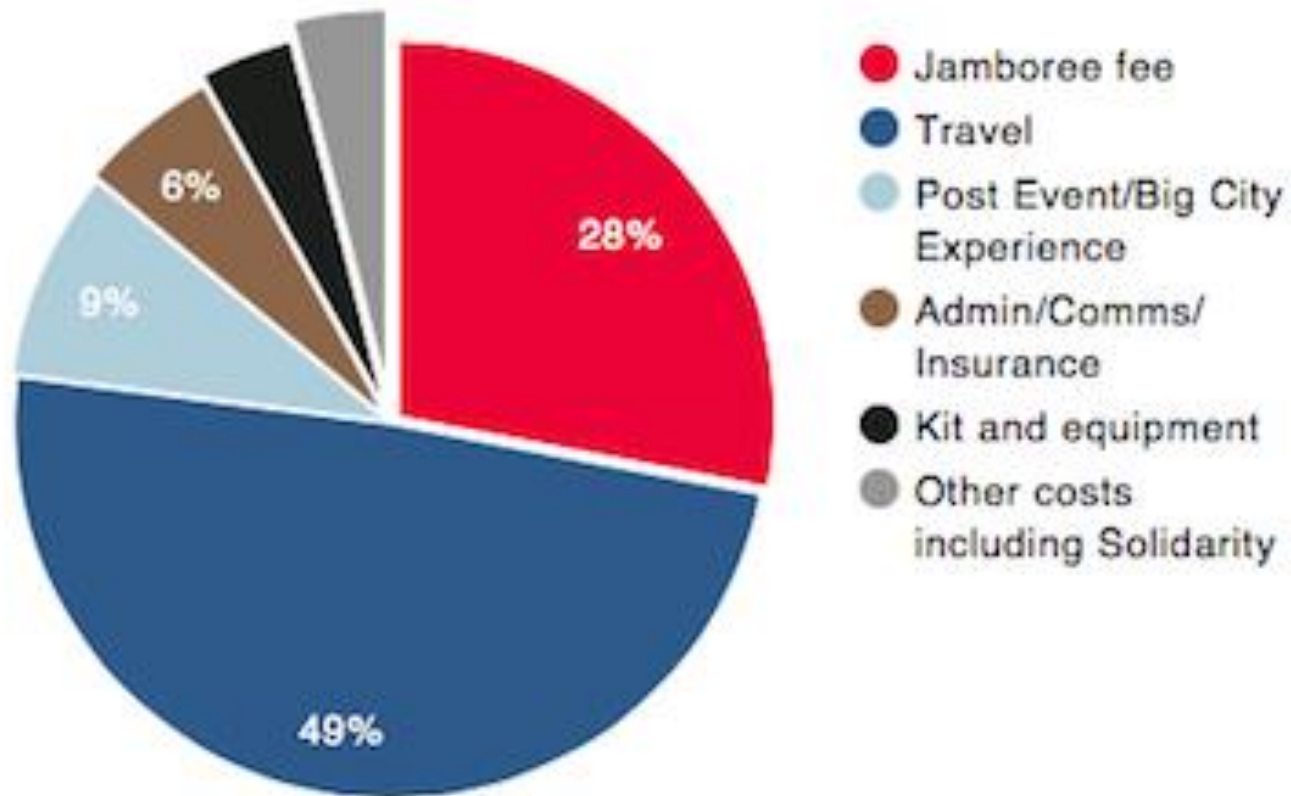


What is included?

- UK and Kent branded kit

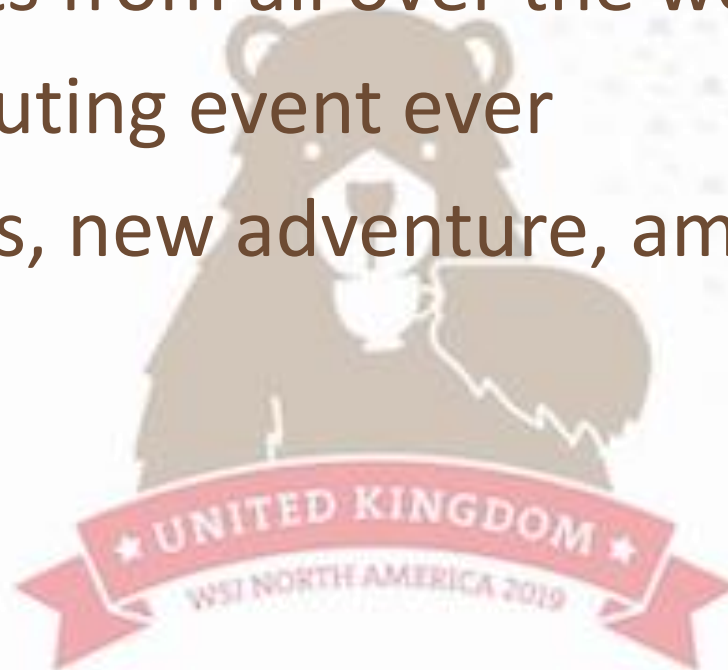


Cost Breakdown

- New friends, new adventure, amazing memories



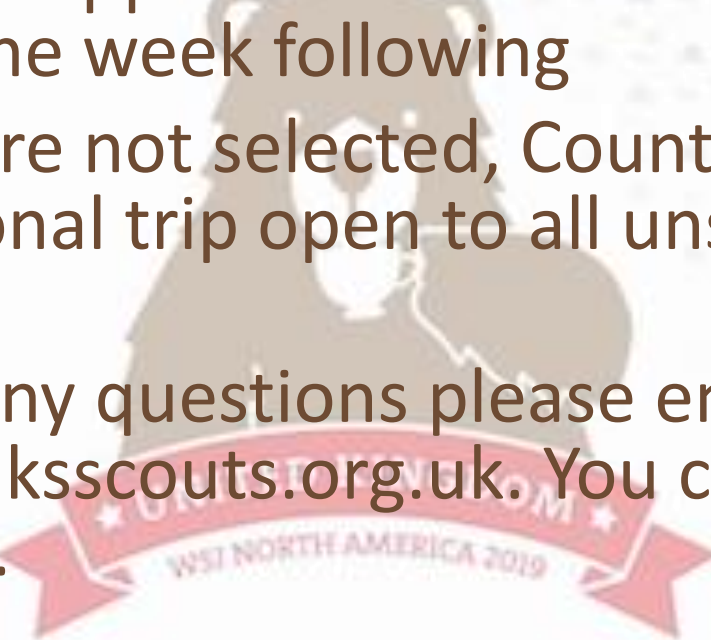
Selection Weekend
